Selected as a Space Shuttle Pilot candidate for NASA's Civilian Spaceflight program. Qualified for active mission status in 1990. (Unfortunately, my flight was cancelled after the Columbia accident).

Worked with the Patriots Jet Team since its formation in 1999. Helped form the Patriots Jet Team Foundation in 2010. Served as mechanic, test pilot, Director of Maintenance, Foundation Board Member, and Chief Instructor for the Academy. Over 28,000 flight hours logged in 22 different aircraft.
